The Naval Shipbuilding College's mission is to ensure a suitably skilled and qualified Australian workforce will be available - at the right time - to meet the needs of industry.




WHAT ARE THE JOBS?

This includes a range of specifically skilled engineers, white collar professionals, trade qualified workers, white card labourers and unqualified workers.





COLLEGE FINDINGS

College undertakes Needs Analyses looking at specific occupations required to build and sustain naval vessels.

In most areas good alignment between training and education programs though some area where industry led on-job training is utilised.

Identification of the need for conceptual skills:

- Ability to understand why tasks are completed to specification.
 - Design requirements
 - Following approved procedures
- Understanding of the contribution the worker is making to the overall build/sustainment project.

The importance of quality and precision

- Vessels are being built to travel into situations that most would be trying to avoid.
- Built for the safety of our naval personnel.
- Built to avoid detection and successfully complete operations.




HOW WILL THE COLLEGE SKILL YOUR WORKFORCE?
